



Mithibai College

Since its inception in 1961, Shri Vile Parle Kelavani Mandal's Mithibai College of Ants, Chauhan Institute of Science & Amnutben Jivanlal College of Commerce and Economics (Autonomous) is envisaged as a destination for the most promising and talented students. The College has 22 departments, of which 14 are postgraduate departments with 10 of them conducting Ph.D. programmes. Its admission policy favours meritorious students irrespective of their economic background. The academic year 2016-17 saw the College being awarded with the Best College Award of University of Mumbai. The College also implemented Grade 1 Autonomous status for a period of 10 years in the academic year 2018-19. The College is granted empowered autonomy in the year 2023-24. In 2019, the College was ranked first by 'India Today' in all three faculties i.e. Arts. Science & Commerce faculty. In 2022, Mithibai College was ranked 4th by 'EduWorld' amongst all Autonomous Colleges in the country. The College has a vibrant and an all-encompassing atmosphere to boost holistic development of its students.

The Department of Zoology

The inception of the department took place in the year 1961 and the first Head of the Department to take charge was Dr. Kalgutkar. Among Prof. Chawathe, Dr. Sakthivel, Prof. Parelkar and Vinayak Dalvie who have been active and dedicated members of Board of Studies, Dr. Sakthivel and Vinayak Dalvie have served the University of Mumbai as Chairpersons, Board of Studies in Zoology. The department, getting its Post Graduate recognition in the year 1980-1981, has entire permanent faculty recognized as Post Graduate teachers as well as guides for M.Sc. by Research. Three faculties of the department are recognized as Ph.D. Guides. The department has published over 190 research papers.



"Animaux" is the official fest organized by the Department of Zoology of Mithibai college. Since 2019, there are a total of eight teams working together for the success of this fest.

"Animaux" as an event focuses on promoting the world of animals and other living organisms to college students. 
- This is a team event with 4 members in each team.

Theme: Animal Antics


- One entry per participant.
