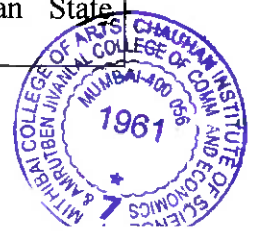

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

Sr. No.	PROGRAMS	ELIGIBILITY
01	Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
02	Bachelor of Arts in Multimedia and Mass Communication (B.A.M.M.C.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
03	Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
04	Bachelor of Commerce (Management & Finance)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
05	Bachelor of Management Studies (B.M.S.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/ other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination or Diploma program in any Engineering Branches with two years or three years after SSC/(Std. X) examination conducted by the Board of Technical Examination or its equivalent examination & Passed with requisite marks in MAH-B.BCA/BBA/BMS/BBM CET 2024 Entrant Examination for Admission to Professional Course in BMS through State Common Entrance Test Cell.
06	Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting & Finance) (B.A.F.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
07	Bachelor of Commerce (Financial Markets) (B.F.M)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.
08	Bachelor of Commerce (Banking and Insurance) (B.B. I.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination (with minimum of 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects) conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination.





Sr. No.	PROGRAMS	ELIGIBILITY
09	Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)	A candidate must have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination. MCVC Stream: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the three years integrated program leading to the degree of Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) must have passed the Higher Secondary Vocational Courses School Certificate (HSC/XII) Examination Certificate (HSC/XII) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Pune. Further, the students, passing the (HSC/XII) examination with the MCVC stream shall be eligible for admission to F.Y.B.Sc. Subject combinations will be displayed on the college website.
10	Bachelor of Science – (Applied Statistics and Data Analytics)	A candidate must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (XII) (with minimum 60 % marks in aggregate of all subjects) in Science stream conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education with Mathematics and Statistics as one of the subjects or its equivalent.
11	Bachelor of Science- (Biotechnology)	A candidate must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (XII) (with minimum 60 % marks in aggregate of all subjects) in Science stream conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination. A candidate who has not offered Mathematics and Statistics as one of the Course at H.S.C. (Std. XII) shall have to satisfactorily complete a bridge course in Mathematics and Statistics during the academic year of First year B.Sc. in which he is admitted.
12	Bachelor of Science (Computer Science)	A candidate must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (XII) (with minimum 60 % marks in aggregate of all subjects) in Science stream conducted by the Maharashtra/other Indian State Boards or equivalent examination with Mathematics and Statistics as one of the courses or its equivalent.
13	Bachelor of Science - (Psychology)	A candidate must have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination (with minimum 60 % marks in aggregate of all subjects) (XII) conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent in any stream.
